No.	Question	Response
1	2.1 Does behaviour support learning in lessons?	Y2- only very occasionally Y3- sometimes when people talk Y4- no most of the time its good Y5- most have good behaviour that helps learning
2	What do adults do if someone misbehaves in the classroom?	Y2- we have the warnings (5 point plan - 5PP) Y3- tell them off and use the colours (5PP) Y4- they give the 'look' and then a warning Y5- tell them off and use the 5PP
3	Can you explain the 5 point Plan?	Y2- as above Y3- knew steps 1-3, confused about 4 & 5 Y4- knew the 5PL steps, they are colour coded, very rare that anyone gets a 5 Y5- know the 5 steps of the 5PL
4	What rewards are there for good behaviour and effort?	Y2- Dojo points, stars, marbles which can lead to a choice of treats such as a pyjama movie Y3- as above Y4- as above Y5- as above
5	What are the rules?	Y2- be kind Y3- be a good friend Y4- hands up and no calling out Y5- the rules we do have are generally well known
6	When do you think behaviour is best?	Y2- when we are learning Y3- during our learning time Y4- during assembly Y5- when we are busy learning
7	When do you think behaviour is worst?	Y2- in football after lunch Y3- lunchtime Y4- playtime after lunch Y5- playtime after we have eaten lunch, but it has got a lot better
8	Do you tell an adult if you think someone's behaviour is really bad? What happens	Y2- yes Y3- yes especially if someone is being picked on

		Y4- yes but when we are on the field at playtimes they are thinly spread out Y5- if it's bad like violence then yes but name calling probably not
9	2.2 Do adults deal with poor behaviour at play and lunch times?	Y2- yes Y3- yes and dinner ladies do as well Y4- yes Y5- yes, this has got a lot better
10	2.3 Is behaviour good when children move around the school?	Y2- yes Y3- yes its good Y4- yes Y5- yes, hands behind our backs helps a lot
11	2.4 Are there many cases of bullying? Are they dealt with? What would you do if you were bullied?	Y2- no Y3- not really but sometimes Y4- its super rare and gets sorted out Y5- no this is very infrequent now
