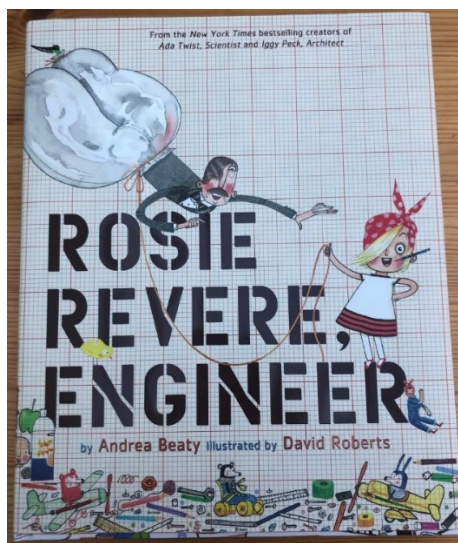


Newsletter 18 – Friday, 30th January 2026
