Vocabulary	Meaning
United Kingdom	A unique kingdom made up of four countries.
capital city	A city where the government of the country is found.
ocean	A very large area of sea.
sea	A large area of salty water that is partly or completely surrounded by land.
North Sea	A part of the Atlantic Ocean that separates Great Britain from north-western Europe.
Irish Sea	A body of water that separates Ireland and Great Britain.
English Channel	A part of the Atlantic Ocean between the UK and France.
Atlantic Ocean	The second largest ocean in the world.
Pacific Ocean	The largest ocean in the world, covering a third of its surface
Indian Ocean	The third largest ocean in the world, surrounding Asia
Arctic Ocean	The ocean around the North Pole
Southern Ocean	The most southerly of the planet's five oceans
