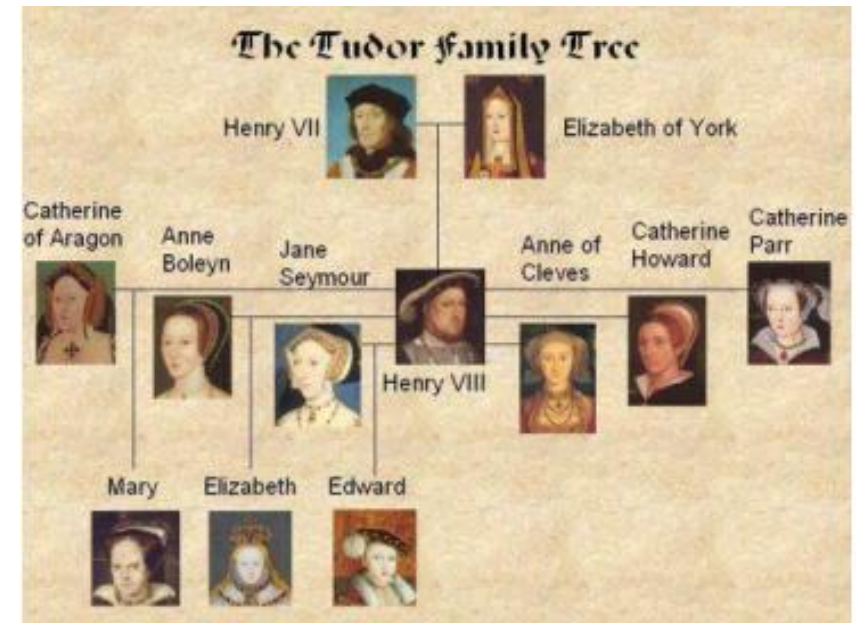

## Who were the Tudors?

The Tudors were a family that ruled England from 1485 to 1603. The first Tudor king was Henry VII. Henry was succeeded by his son, who became Henry VIII. Henry wanted a male heir to continue the Tudor line.

**Catherine of Aragon** was Henry VIII first wife, she didn't give him a son so he wanted to divorce her.

**Anne Boleyn** was Henry VIII second wife, he thought that if he divorced Catherine and married Anne, she might give him a son.

**Henry** split from the **Catholic church** because the Pope wouldn't allow him to get a divorce. Henry decided that he should be head of the church instead of the Pope and formed the **Church of England**, which still exists today.
